

ASSAM UNIVERSITY : SILCHAR NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of decision of the Academic Council vide Resolution No. AC:93: 04-23:19 and Executive Council Vide Resolution No. EC:156: 04-23:11, it is hereby notified that a Special chance examination for PG/UG/Integrated/LLB/B.Ed courses will be held for the candidates who have exhausted all their admissible chances to appear in the examination from 2017 to 2022.

The Special Chance Examination 2023 will be held as per following terms & conditions :-

- Those who were otherwise eligible and availed of any Special chance examination earlier are not qualified to apply in Special chance Examination, 2023.
- The number of arrear paper will not be more than the total number of semester(s) of the Programme.
- The special chance examination will be conducted in two consecutive semester examinations (Even and Odd semester examination) of 2023.
- The candidate will apply for permission of Special Chance Examination 2023 for both Odd & Even semesters to the Head of Department/Principal of Concerned Department/College from 6th July to 30th July 2023 as per format (attached).
- The Head of the Department/Principal of concerned College will forward the application to Controller of Examinations by 05th August 2023 after necessary scrutiny.
- The candidate will be informed by the department/college regarding his/her eligibility for appearing the examination.
- The candidate may apply for respective Even and Odd semester examinations, 2023 after obtaining permission as per normal procedure as and when the schedule of examination is notified.
- 8. The eligible candidate will have to pay the following fees per examination:-
 - Rs. 300/- per Paper subject to minimum of Rs. 500/- & maximum of Rs. 1500/-
 - ii) Rs. 300/- centre fee.
 - iii) Marksheet fee Rs. 75/- per semester.
